Carnation Elementary provides a variety of learning experiences and styles for our students and a wide range of choices for parents and families.

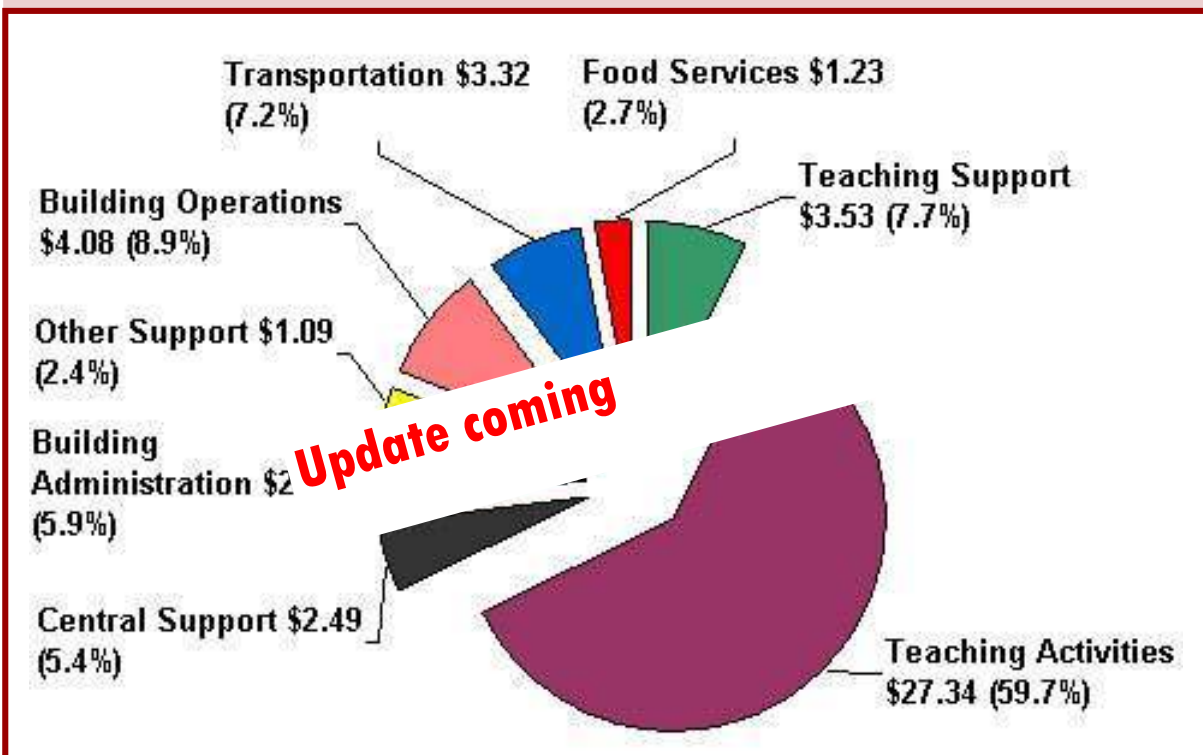
